

## Art and Design Key Skills Y3

Area	Key Skill
<b>Create and Communicate</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Create sketch books to record observations and use these to review and revisit ideas</li> </ul>
<b>Using Techniques to create Effects</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To improve mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting and sculpture with a range of materials</li> </ul>
<b>Drawing</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Experiment with ways in which surface detail can be added to drawings</li> <li>• Collect and record visual information from different sources</li> <li>• Draw for a sustained period of time at an appropriate level</li> <li>• Make marks and lines with a wide range of drawing implements e.g. charcoal, pencil, crayon, chalk pastels, pens etc</li> <li>• Experiment with different grades of pencil</li> <li>• Begin to show and awareness of 'objects in the round'</li> </ul>
<b>Digital Media</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Record and collect visual information using digital cameras and video recorders</li> </ul>
<b>Painting</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Experiment with different effects and textures including blocking in colour, washes, thickened paint creating textural effects</li> <li>• Work on a range of scales e.g. thin brush on a small picture</li> <li>• Create different effects and textures with paint according to what they need for the task</li> <li>• Mix colours and know which primary colours make secondary colours</li> <li>• Use more specific language vocabulary</li> </ul>
<b>Printing</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Create printing blocks using a relief or impressed method</li> <li>• Create repeating patterns</li> <li>• Print with two colour overlays</li> </ul>
<b>Textiles</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Change and modify thread and fabrics by knotting, twisting and plaiting</li> <li>• Cut and shape fabric using scissors</li> </ul>

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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Apply shapes and decoration with glue or by simple stitching</li><li>• Create fabrics by weaving materials</li></ul>
<b>3D</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Plan, design and make models from observation or imagination</li><li>• Join clay and construct a simple base for extending and modelling other shapes</li><li>• Create surface patterns and textures in a malleable material</li></ul>
<b>Collage</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Experiment with a range of collage techniques such as tearing, overlapping and layering to create images and represent textures</li><li>• Use collage as a means of collecting ideas and information and building a visual vocabulary</li><li>• Create different effects and textures with paint according to what they need for a task</li></ul>
<b>Appreciate Artists</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To cite and describe the work of great artists and designers in history</li><li>• To make links with their work and artists' work</li></ul>
