Area	Key Skill
Create and Communicate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create sketch books to record observations and use these to review and revisit ideas
Using Techniques to create Effects	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To improve mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting and sculpture with a range of materials
Drawing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Work from a variety of sources including observation, photographs and digital images • Work in a sustained and independent way to create a detailed drawing • Develop close observation skills using a view finder • Collect and develop ideas • Identify artists who have worked in a similar way to their own work • Experiment with wet media to make different marks, lines and shapes • Explore colour mixing and blending techniques with coloured pencils • Start to develop their own style using contrast and mixed media
Perspective and Composition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Begin to use simple perspective in their work using a single focal point and horizon • Show an awareness of how paintings are created
Digital Media	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Record and collect visual information using digital cameras and video • Present recorded visual images using software e.g. Photostory, Powerpoint • Be able to import an image (scanned, retrieved, taken) into a graphics package • Understand that a digital image is created by layering • Create layered images from original ideas

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Painting	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Develop a painting from a drawing• Carry out preliminary studies• Create imaginative work from a variety of sources e.g. observational drawing, themes, poetry, music• Mix and match colours to create atmosphere and light effects• Be able to identify primary, secondary, complimentary and contrasting colours• Work with complementary colours• Use more specific language vocabulary
Textiles	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use fabrics to create 3D structures• Experiment with batik techniques
3D	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Shape, form, model and construct from observation or imagination• Use recycled, natural and manmade materials to create sculptures• Plan a sculpture through drawing and other preparatory work• Develop skills in using clay including slabs, coils, slips etc• Produce intricate patterns and textures in a malleable media
Collage	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use different techniques, colours and textures when designing and making pieces of work• Add collage to a painted, printed or drawn background• Use a range of media to create collages
Appreciate Artists	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To cite and describe the work of great artists and designers in history• To make links with their work and artists' work
