

Swalwell Primary School Sports Premium Plan 2016-2017

This year school will receive approximately £8,638 to invest in the provision and promotion of sport, activity and healthy lifestyles across the school. In addition to this there is further spend encapsulated within the school budget representing staffing costs involved in competitions, out of school club coaching, costs relating to transport to and from venues, some of which is partly covered by the Sports Premium and partly by school.

Ofsted recommendations are that investment should "impact on increasing **participation**, **promoting health and wellbeing** and **improving performance** of all children and groups" and these are coloured according to the area of impact we are aiming to improve.

Tag Rugby - Year 6	Using GSSP free coaching block for premium members	Prepare children for event and the year group also had coaching on this last year and tried exceptionally well at local competitions. Provides links with Blaydon Rugby Club. Year 6 children enjoy this every year.
FA Skills-supporting PE and Teacher Development-Year 2 & 3	Free	Year 2 & 3 participation and association with the FA Skills, sharing best practice and supporting Teachers all in one half term, whilst the children enjoy top quality P.E.
Gymnastics Coaching - Year 4 Gymnastics After School Club-KS2	£350	Full term coaching KS2 After School Club to Prepare children for event and also had coaching on this last year and did exceptionally well at local competitions , Good links also with AIM club and have had several children go onto club coaching outside of school.

Football Coaching - KS1 & KS2	£250	Full term coaching, for many children at Swalwell primary school, football is the perfect lesson. A lot of our pupils will likely come to the lesson with experience of playing football at home with friends, and will have plenty of enthusiasm and excitement for the game. This enthusiasm will help keep lessons fun and engaging.
Dance KS1 & KS2	£350	For children to develop a sense of rhythm, improve coordination and to draw an association with dance as a mean of healthy living and fitness . As well as seeing how other cultures view dance and perform it. Also Preparing children for Gateshead Dance Festival event at the Sage.
Martial Arts-KS1 Keep Active inspiration through positive activity All activities are inclusive, available to everyone regardless of background or ability	£180	Great way to engage children to develop flexibility, balance, agility and co-ordination and gives them the opportunity to apply them through Martial Arts. They are taught to vary the way they perform their skills by using tactics and different movements. They have lots of opportunity to observe, describe and copy what others have done.
Archery -KS2 Keep Active inspiration through positive activity	£90	One half term of coaching to introduce basic archery techniques and the different shooting styles.
Basketball coaching- Year 4	£210	Year 4 Participation and preparation for competitions. This will support pupil progress and improve impact in external competitions
Swimming-ARMS children	£340	Two full terms of swimming coaching at Cedars Academy school providing a fantastic introduction into swimming for our ARMS children. Two of the ARMs children also attend Gateshead Kestrels Disability sports club.
Play worker employed-5 lunchtimes a week	£3,198	Providing a caring, secure environment, through individual attention and group activities, and to organise an appropriate range of leisure activities for children between the ages of 4 to 11. Promoting health and well-being at lunchtimes.
Playground equipment and transport.	£1020	Cover costs for new or replacement equipment and transport for children to attend events.
